Numbered Notes:

- **Note 1: Transfer course recommendations.** ENG 114 Prof Research & Reporting at WTCC will meet the ODU ENGL 211C Writing, Rhetoric, and Research requirement. MAT 152 Statistical Methods 1 at WTCC will meet the ODU Dental Hygiene math requirement for STAT 130 Elementary Statistics. BIO 169 Anatomy & Physiology II at WTCC will meet the ODU BIO 241 Fundamentals of Anatomy & Physiology II requirement. BIO 275 Microbiology at WTCC will meet ODU's BIOL 150 Intro Microbiology and BIO 151 Intro Microbiology Lab requirement.
- **Note 2: Departmental Chemistry Requirement.** The ODU Dental Hygiene program requires Introductory Chemistry with a lab. Students will need to complete this requirement at WTCC by taking CHM 131 Introduction to Chemistry and CHM 131A Introduction to Chemistry Lab which transfers to ODU as CHEM 105N Introductory Chemistry and CHEM 106N Introductory Chemistry Lab.

- **Note 3: Liberal Arts Requirement.** Depending upon course completion, 6-9 additional credit hours in ODU lower-division general education areas of Literature, Human Creativity, Philosophy and Ethics, Interpreting the Past, and Language and Culture will need to be completed. Any courses needed to complete the Liberal Arts requirement may be taken at WTCC, ODU, and/or approved standardized examination (i.e., CLEP, DSST).
- **Note 4: Transferability of the Arts and Humanities Elective varies by course selection.** Before enrolling in an WTCC General Ed Arts/Humanities course, seek guidance from an ODU enrollment coordinator or email academicpartnerships@odu.edu to ensure transferability to meet ODU's Liberal Arts General Ed req. Students who complete one of the selected WTCC Humanities/Fine Arts Electives (ART 111 Art Appreciation, ART 114 Art History Survey I, or ART 115 Art History Survey II) will meet 3 credits towards ODU's Liberal Arts requirement.
- **Note 5: Transferability of DHY courses.** Credit hours from the Associate of Applied Science in Dental Hygiene program are used to satisfy the BSDH Post-licensure Online Program as academic electives.
- **Note 6: Upper Division General Education.** Complete 15 credits at the 300/400 level to meet the upper division requirement; 6 credits (out of the 15) must be from a subject outside of and not required by the student's major and college.

General Notes:

- Completion of this transfer agreement guide alone does not guarantee admission to Old Dominion University. All students must meet the requirements set by the Office of Admissions. An additional application is required specifically for the Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene (BSDH) Post-Licensure Online Program. Formal acceptance into the dental hygiene program will be determined by the Admissions Committee for the BSDH Post-Licensure Online Program.
- Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU. Students must notify their ODU academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
- Grade of C or higher is required to receive transfer course credit from AAS courses, and all ODU Dental Hygiene (DNTH) courses require a C or higher.
- A minimum of 120 credit hours is required for graduation. Students can transfer up to 90 credit hours into select ODU majors with the completion of an associates degree. A minimum of 30 credit hours must be completed at ODU.
- **Linked Bachelor's to Master's degree option:** Eligible students can apply to the Linked [Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene online program](#) to [Master of Science in Dental Hygiene online program](#). Qualified undergraduates can take up to 12 hours of graduate coursework that may be applied to both degrees.
- Course requirements listed in this agreement are based on the 2023-2024 catalogs for each institution and are valid until 2027, unless annual catalog curriculum changes or an updated agreement guide is created.
- **Students are encouraged to complete the Letter of Intent (LOI)** to gain access to exclusive benefits, including pre-advising, coaching, and a waived application fee. Submit the LOI at <https://online.odu.edu/transfer-intent>.


