Numbered Notes:

- **Note 1: Transfer course options.** Lower-level general education courses can be taken at MCC, ODU, and/or standardized examination (i.e. CLEP, DSST). *To ensure optimal transfer of credits, students are strongly encouraged to consult with an ODU enrollment coordinator before registering for general education courses at MCC.*
- **Note 2: Departmental Statistics Requirement.** MCC students pursuing the Health Services Administration program at ODU are strongly encouraged to take MAT 206 Elements of Statistics at MCC. This course fulfills ODU's Health Services Administration department statistics requirement.
- **Note 3: Nature of Science Requirement.** ODU requires 4 credit hours of an approved science course with a lab. This course may be completed at ODU or MCC.
- **Note 4: Social Science Requirement.** Depending on course selection, MCC students will need to complete 3-6 credit hours of lower-division general education Social Science coursework. This may be completed at MCC or at ODU.
- **Note 5: Humanities Requirement.** ODU requires 6 credit hours in ODU lower-division general education Humanities courses. As part of the ODU Health Administration curriculum, students will fulfill 3 credit hours of this requirement within the major by completing PHIL 345E Bioethics. Students who do not transfer in equivalent coursework will need to fulfill the 3 remaining credit hours at ODU.
- **Note 6: General Education Elective Requirement.** Depending on course selection, MCC students will need to complete 6-9 credit hours in ODU lower-division General Education Elective coursework. This may be completed at MCC or ODU.
- **Note 7: MCC Health Science Program Pre-Requisites.** Per MCC Health Science program pre-requisites, HCC 130 Fundamentals in Health Care Delivery and HCC 145 Medical Terminology may be met by work experience or equivalent course education as evaluated by the GateWay Health Core Curriculum.

- Completion of this transfer agreement guide alone does not guarantee admission to Old Dominion University. All students must meet the requirements set by the Office of Admissions.
- A grade of C or higher is required to receive transfer course credit.
- A minimum of 120 credit hours is required for graduation. Students must earn a minimum of 30 credits at Old Dominion University to be eligible for a degree.
- Course requirements listed in this agreement are based on the 2025-2026 catalogs for each institution and are valid until 2029, unless annual catalog curriculum changes or an updated agreement guide is created.
